

Location, Location, Location!

Prince Edward County is located at the east end of Lake Ontario, just south of Belleville, Ontario. Although we are technically an island, we have continued access to the mainland with 3 bridges and a year-round ferry.

We are a convenient midpoint between Toronto and Ottawa, with easy access to the 401. This makes us an ideal option for those looking for a safer and more rural lifestyle but still close to larger centres.


Where Quality Care Lives in Prince Edward County

Prince Edward County Memorial Hospital

A small rural hospital with 18 inpatient beds and a 24-hour Emergency Department. Family physicians have the option to work in ER if they choose to, allowing them to customize their practice model. The hospital is also equipped with an Endoscopy Suite and hosts a variety of specialty clinics. There's a brand new hospital in development, planned to open in 2027.

Long Term Care and Hospice With 4 long term care homes and a 3-bed residential hospice, supportive and service-oriented care is never far away. Working at one of these facilities is another option to augment your practice.

Beaches


The sandy Dune beaches of Sandbanks Provincial Park are world renowned. The sugar-like white sand and turquoise waters make you forget where you are.

Recreational Amenities

Prince Edward Fitness and Aquatic Centre

Located in Picton, the centre has a full range of cardio and weight training equipment, squash court, cycle room and a full-length swimming pool. You can also book personal training and group fitness classes to support your fitness journey.

The Prince Edward Community Centre

Features a new playground and skate park with canteen, two ball diamonds, grandstands, the historic Crystal Palace event venue and even a curling club.

Wellington and District Community Centre

This modern recreation centre is used for hockey, skating, special events, tournaments, etc. It features a regulation NHL size ice pad, walking track and a small fitness area.

Golf Courses

There are two golf courses located right in The County, including a 9-hole course just outside Wellington and a full 18hole course just north of Picton.

Prince Edward Yacht Club (PEYC) One of the finest land-locked small harbours in Canada, the PEYC is located in the quiet and picturesque inlet at the head of Picton Bay.
